- ⇒ Create a Quiet Place: Designate a calming space where your loved one can retreat if they become overwhelmed.
- ⇒ **Communicate:** It can be helpful to let friends and family know in advance about any changes they might see in your loved one since they last saw them.
- ⇒ **Be Flexible:** Give yourself permission to do only what you can reasonably and safely manage and be prepared to adapt plans based on your loved ones needs or energy level.
- ⇒ **Prioritize Well-Being:** Maintain daily routines as much as possible to minimize disruption and confusion. Remember, it is OK to prioritize self-care and take breaks when needed.
- ⇒ **Seek Support:** Seek support from friends, family, or support groups to help manage the emotional and practical challenges of the holidays.
